CONSIDERATIONS

2. This product will be updated from time to time via cloud or USB storage. New features might change the operation of the unit. Please do not use this document if not relevant to the current version. 3. Service and Hand Brake Tests (Emergency) are conducted with the same method.

TO START A NEW TEST

1. Open the application
2. Select **“New Test”**
3. Enter the examiner name
4. Enter vehicle registration
5. Select road condition
6. Select road surface
7. Confirm details and press **“START”**
8. Position unit on selected surface with arrow facing in direction of movement
9. Wait for self-compensating bar to be filled
10. Accelerate vehicle to controlled speed
11. Do emergency brake without wheel lock
12. Test report will display
13. Send report
